Helpful services and access options are available throughout Walt Disney World Resort for Guests with mobility disabilities.

Walt Disney World attractions offer access for Guests with mobility disabilities in the following categories:

- Must transfer from wheelchair/ECV to ride vehicle
- Must transfer from ECV to wheelchair
- Must transfer from ECV to wheelchair, and from wheelchair to ride vehicle
- May Remain in Wheelchair/ECV

Universal Studios Orlando:

Guests Using Manual Wheelchairs And ECVs

With the exception of Hogwarts™ Express, none of the ride vehicles or attraction queues at Universal Orlando™ can accommodate Electric Convenience Vehicles (ECVs) or motorized wheelchairs. At the rides that can accommodate manual wheelchairs, you may transfer from your ECV or motorized wheelchair into a manual wheelchair provided at each location. If you can't transfer to a manual wheelchair, please see an Attractions Attendant.

Sesame Place:

Accessibility Guide for Guests with Cognitive Disabilities & Other Special Needs

Our Ride Accessibility Program (RAP) matches the individual abilities of our guests to the requirements of each ride. The RAP is designed to allow guests to fully participate in the enjoyment of our park while keeping in mind the safety requirements of our rides and attractions. The program was developed based on the requirements of the ride manufacturer and by evaluating the physical and mental attributes required to safely ride each ride. It is our policy to allow anyone to ride our rides and enjoy our attractions as long as they meet all these requirements and such that it does not present a potential hazard to the guest or to others.

Busch Gardens, Tampa:

Guests with casts or braces will be restricted from riding certain rides where the cast or brace may present a hazard to the guest or others. Please consult with our Guest Services staff for more information or if in doubt about your ability to safely experience a ride.

Busch Gardens® team members can offer assistance steadying a guest transferring to or from a wheelchair. They may not lift or assist in lifting anyone using a wheelchair. All guests must be able to board a ride themselves or with help from a member of their party.
